## Narrative

On 8/12/2024 at approximately 0117 hours, while assisting Patrolman Antonio Flores on a motor vehicle stop on State Route 36 North and Allyson Lane, I observed a gray Toyota Tundra bearing NJ Registration G10MCJ traveling at a high rate of speed past the motor vehicle stop. At that time, I entered marked patrol vehicle 1711 to catch up to the accused vehicle. Once at the vehicle, I observed the vehicle fail to maintain its lane specifically by swerving into the left lane on State Route 36 North and swerved back into the right lane and into the shoulder. At that time, I activated my emergency lights system to conduct a motor vehicle stop. The vehicle came to a complete stop on 7th Avenue just off Memorial Pkwy in the Borough of Atlantic Highlands, NJ.

I exited my patrol vehicle, activated my body worn camera (BWC), and approached the vehicle from the driver's side. It should be noted that while approaching the vehicle, I could detect a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the vehicle. Once at the vehicle, I asked the female operator for her documents and as she retrieved them, her hand movements were slow and fumbling. I further observed the driver's eyes to be watery. I asked the driver where she was coming from to which she said, "2nd Jetty". I asked the driver how much she had to drink, and she said, "Two beers". The driver's license provided identified the driver as Haley Rosset.

At that time, I asked Rosset to exit the vehicle to conduct the Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFSTs). The roadway was level and clear of debris.

The first SFST Rosset was instructed in was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN). Reference Patrolman Joseph Labellas supplement for further. See BWC footage for further details.

I asked Rosset if she knew the English alphabet and if she could recite it from A to Z without signing it. Throughout both of her attempts, she could not complete the alphabet successfully. She mixed multiple words up and was slurring throughout the alphabet.

The second SFST Rosset was instructed in completing was the walk and turn test (WAT). She was placed in the starting position and advised not to start until told to do so. It should be noted that she stepped out of the starting position. Once I completed my demonstration, she stated that she understood the test and later began it. Throughout the test, Rosset did not touch heel to toe, lost her balance, stepped off line and used her arms for balance. See BWC for further details.

The third SFST Rosset was instructed in completing was the one leg stand test (OLS). After the completion of my instructions, she stated that she understood the test and later began it. Rosset lifted her foot less than six inches above the ground, used her arms for balance, and placed her foot on the ground. See BWC for further details.

My observations of Rosset and the clues of impairment throughout her SFSTs were consistent with indicators present in a subject under the influence of alcohol. Rosset was placed in double locked handcuffs behind her person, patted down for officer safety, and placed in the rear of marked patrol vehicle 1711 for transport to the Highlands Police Department. Patrolman Flores and I conducted a search of the vehicle for intoxicants with yielded negative results.

During my transport to the Highlands Police Department, the inside of my vehicle filled with the odor of an alcoholic beverage through the closed partition. Once at the Highlands Police Department, Rosset was read her Miranda Rights and the

Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators ( N.J.S.A. 39:4-50.2(E) ). She signed the Miranda Warning and advised me that she would answer any questions I had. Rosset was further advised that the law requires her to submit samples of her breath for testing. She replied, "Yes". At that time, Sergeant Connor McGrath conducted the Alcotest for Rosset which came back with a BAC was a .23.

After processing, Rosset was released to a sober party with a pending court appearance in the Highlands Municipal court. The vehicle was towed from the scene by Hennessey's Towing for the mandatory John's Law impound.

JJL I, Ptlm. LaBella responded to the above location to conduct HGN for Ptlm. Connor (17060). After conclusion of the HGN Test, Rosset's pupils were both equally sized with equal tracking. Rosset lacked smooth pursuit from both eyes meaning her eyes were not moving smoothly as she was following my stimulus. I then checked onset prior to 45 degrees in which I observed a distinct and sustained involuntary jerking of both eyes. Next I checked maximum deviation in which I observed a distinct and sustained involuntary jerking of both eyes. Lastly I checked Rosset's vertical gaze nystagmus. I was unable to observe vertical gaze nystagmus in either of her eyes due to Rosset failing to follow the stimulus with her eyes only. Subject kept moving her head.

No further incident.
