<b>Details of Incident (Indicate Means of Identification)</b>							
On March 25, 2025, I was dispatched to Hobart Ave for a single-car motor vehicle accident at 1929 hours.							
Dispatch advised that the vehicle was off the roadway and struck a telephone pole but was unsure of any injuries. Officer Nacim was the first officer on scene and advised that the driver was trapped in the vehicle and requested BLS and the fire department to come on scene. The telephone pole (JCPL ticket # 359410524 ) that was struck was also severed in half, but no live wires were seen to cause harm. MSHVFAS arrived on scene with the Millburn Fire Department and was able to remove the driver from the vehicle. The driver, now known as Jennifer Chinchilla, was removed and rendered first aid from the squad. She appeared to have a small laceration on her forehead and her finger...

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Officer Nacim detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from Jennifer breath and car, along with a brown liquid with a slice of an orange in a clear cup found in the passenger seat. Jennifer was also stumbling as she was walking and slurring her speech. Jennifer signed an RMA and refused medical treatment. Knowing the given information of the incident, Jennifer was believed to be under the influence, and SFSTs were then started to dictate Jennifer's condition. See Officer Kerwien's Report for the HGN test.

I then conducted the Walk and Turn test for Jennifer. Jennifer was positioned on the solid yellow line in the roadway and was given the instructions for this test. I further explained to Jennifer to watch me demonstrate the test until I tell her to begin. I advised Jennifer to put her left foot on the line with her right foot placed in front, touching heel to toe. Then take 9 heel-to-toe steps with your arms placed to the side. After taking the 9 steps, make a series of smaller steps to turn around and take 9 steps back the same way. Jennifer was instructed to begin after acknowledging the information I explained. Jennifer failed to touch heel to toe for all her steps and walked off the line on step 3 and 4, After the series of small steps, Jennifer took 10 steps instead of 9 that I counted and walked off the line on step 2 on her way back.

The last test I conducted was the One Leg Stand. I demonstrated the exam by explaining that you must keep your feet together with your hands at your side. Then, using whichever leg of her choice, raise it 6 inches off the ground with your toe pointed forward, counting forward from 1001. Jennifer acknowledged the information and was instructed to start. Jennifer had difficulties maintaining balance and could not keep her hands down towards her side. She was also seen putting her foot down and losing her balance. With the performance of the tests that were provided, Jennifer was placed under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated. She was placed in the prisoner compartment of vehicle 12 and transported to Millburn Police Department by Officer Nacim. Officer Recinos then operated the Alcotest machine on Jennifer. See Officer Recinos report. Jennifer's vehicle was then towed by C&L Towing and placed on a 12-hour hold as per John's Law.

Nick Biase then responded to Millburn Police Department to take custody of Jennifer and was explained the purpose of the potential liability form. That form was then filled out and signed, and Jennifer was released to Nick to take custody of her. Jennifer issued 5 tickets for this incident as follows: 0712 E25 002943, 0712 E25 002945, 0712 E25 002946, 0712 E25 002947, and 0712 E25 002948.

Nothing further to report. Incident captured on BWC64.
