Narrative

On the above date and time, I responded to the above location for the report of a motor vehicle crash involving Ptl. Mason #66 while he was on an Off Duty Employment. Upon arrival I met with Ptl. Mason #66 who at that time had the subject later identified as Rohini Singh at the rear of her vehicle with her hands behind her back due to her being extremely noncompliant by yelling and attempting to pull away from patrol.

I place Ms. Singh in handcuffs utilizing the double locking mechanism. While placing Ms. Singh in handcuffs I began to smell the odor and an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath. I also observed Ms. Singh with glassy eyes as well as slurred speech. Due to Ms. Singh's extreme combativeness and noncompliance I was unable to perform roadside Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST).

I placed Ms. Singh in the rear passenger seat advising her she was under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated (DWI). While retrieving Ms. Singh's cell phone and purse from the vehicle a mostly empty 375mL bottle of 40 proof, 20% ALC/VOL "On The Rocks Hornitos Tequila" was located in the center console of the vehicle. Ms. Singh's purse and cellphone were retrieved and then placed on the front passenger seat floor.

At that time, I began transporting Ms. Singh back to police headquarters to begin processing, starting and ending milage was recorded by MCRR. Upon arrival at headquarters I secured my firearm in gun lock box #3 prior to retrieving Ms. Singh from the rear of my patrol vehicle. When opening the back door of my patrol vehicle a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanated from the rear passenger compartment of my patrol vehicle. Ms. Singh stumbled getting out of the vehicle by falling it the passenger door as she exited the patrol vehicle. I escorted Ms. Singh from the sally port to the booking room to begin processing.

Ms. Singh was extremely uncooperative during the entire booking process by yelling and accusing patrol of being racist. Sgt Molinelli #60 performed a search of Ms. Singh yielding negative weapons or contraband. Ms. Singh was secured to the booking room bench while being processed.

Ptl. Kapp #44 advised Ms. Singh of her Miranda Rights and read the New Jersey standard statement, where she replied "No" refusing to consent to providing breathe samples.

It should be noted during processing Ms. Singh asked numerous times what she was under arrest for and where her vehicle was located. Patrol advised her multiple times her vehicle was being towed to Marlboro Auto body and that she was under arrest for D.W.I. Brianna Fox responded to headquarters and signed the potential liability form. Ms. Singh was photographed and released with her summonses with a future court date. All appropriate forms were completed and placed in the case folder. No further police action.

On the above date and time I, Patrolman Brian Mason #66, was working an off duty detail in the area of CR-537 and Five Points Road. I was operating vehicle 35 which is a fully marked vehicle with emergency lights activated. It should be noted that I was not equipped with my BWC due to working a traffic detail. I was positioned within the work zone, the work zone was both lanes of CR-537 heading westbound, and the westbound traffic was properly shifted to the left lane of CR-537 eastbound and the right lane continued to have traffic traveling eastbound, effectively making the roadway one lane in each direction.

As I was stationed at my post, I heard a vehicle horn going off and I immediately began looking to see where this was coming from. While doing so, I heard and felt a slight impact into the rear of my vehicle. I quickly exited vehicle 35 and observed a black SUV, later identified as NJ reg. [REDACTED] up against the rear passenger of my vehicle. I advised MCRR that I was involved in a MVA, at which time Sgt. Ward and Ptl. Ferlisi advised that they were responding. I observed the vehicle to be operated by a female, later identified as Rohini Singh. The vehicle began reversing while I was approaching it, I began to order the female to stop the vehicle and she continued to reverse. I was able to get to the driver side window of the vehicle and ordered Ms. Singh to stop, I began to bang on the window to get her attention. At this time, I observed Ms. Singh to possibly be confused and her eyes to be watery. Eventually, Ms. Singh stopped the vehicle and rolled the window down. I ordered her to open the door, as the vehicle was still in reverse and I observed her movements to be slowed and fumbling to open the door. At this time, I reached inside and opened the door and immediately reached across her and placed the vehicle into park. While doing so, I detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the passenger compartment of the vehicle. I ordered Ms. Singh to shut off the vehicle and she complied. As I spoke with her, I detected her speech to be slowed and slurred. She continued to ramble about going home and taking care of her daughter. During this time she would go from moments of being calm to being extremely aggressive and screaming at me. She began to fumble around with the gear shift, I ordered her to exit the vehicle and speak to me outside. She complied, as she walked to the rear of the vehicle she stumbled and appeared to be uneasy on her feet.

I attempted to speak to her and it did not appear that she was aware that she had struck my vehicle. She became increasingly aggressive advising me that she needed to go home and for me just to listen to her. I advised her to just standby for a moment while I contacted MCRR and responding units. At this time, Ms. Singh attempted to return to her vehicle and I stood in front of her advising her to stay outside. She attempted to push past me and continued screaming at me. At this time, due to her level of intoxication and combativeness, I advised her that she was under arrest and placed her arms behind her back, during this time she tensed up and refused to provide me with her left arm and tucked it between herself and her vehicle. I advised MCRR that I had one resisting at this time. Eventually, she placed her second arm behind her back and I was able to hold her in this position until Ptl. Ferlisi arrived on scene and she was placed into handcuffs. See his report for further.

I stood by with the vehicle until the arrival of the tow truck. At this time the vehicle was removed and I returned back to my post.

On 12/10/2025 I assisted Ptl. Ferlisi in the processing of a subject who he arrested for DWI. I was awaiting HQ for Ptl. Ferlisi's arrival in the department processing room located at our HQ. Ptl. Ferlisi arrived at our HQ and assisted the accused into the processing room/cell area. The accused was handcuffed to the processing bench. I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the accused breath as she spoke. She was irate at the fact that she was arrested and kept asking what she was arrested for. She was told multiple times for DWI. She kept making the statement "its because I'm brown and ya''ll are racist and hate brown people".

Sgt. Molinelli searched the accused in the processing room and adjacent cell area for weapons (negative results) and returned her to the bench. At this time I checked the accused's mouth cavity for debris/gum/contraband and her mouth was free and clear. I started the 20 min. direct observation as per the Alcotest at 2105hrs.

I then read the NJ Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicles word for word to the accused. When asked to provide samples of her breath she responded "NO".

Her answer was recorded on the same. A refusal test was conducted and completed on the Alcotest. All documents included in the case file.....

Officer Investigation:

V1 was traveling west bound on CR 537 through an active construction zone. V2, a police vehicle with the emergency lights activated, was parked within the construction zone out of the temporary lane of travel. V1 failed to maintain its lane and ran over multiple traffic cones, leaving the temporary lane of travel and entering the work zone. 

**N.J. ATTORNEY GENERAL'S STANDARD STATEMENT
FOR MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS (N.J.S.A. 39:4-50.2(e))
(revised & effective July 1, 2012)**

Enter Defendant's Name ROHINI SINGH

The police officer shall read the following:

1. You have been arrested for driving while intoxicated. N.J.S.A. 39:4-50.
2. The law requires you to submit samples of your breath for the purpose of testing to determine alcohol content.
3. A record of the taking of the breath samples, including the test results, will be made. Upon your request, a copy of that record will be made available to you.
4. After you have provided samples of your breath for testing, you have the right, at your own expense, to have a person or physician of your own selection take independent samples of your breath, blood or urine for independent testing.
5. If you refuse to provide samples of your breath, you will be issued a separate summons for the refusal. A court may find you guilty of both refusal and driving while intoxicated.
6. If a court finds you guilty of the refusal, you will be subject to various penalties, including license revocation of up to 20 years, a fine of up to \$2000, installation of an ignition interlock, and referral to an Intoxicated Driver Resource Center. These penalties may be in addition to penalties imposed by the court for any other offense of which you are found guilty.
7. You have no legal right to have an attorney, physician or anyone else present for the purpose of taking the breath samples. You have no legal right to refuse to give, or delay giving, samples of your breath.
8. Any response from you that is ambiguous or conditional, in any respect, to my request that you provide breath samples, will be treated as a refusal to submit to breath testing. Even if you agree to take the test, but then do not follow my instructions, do not properly perform the test, or do not provide sufficient breath samples, I will charge you with refusal to submit to breath testing.
9. I repeat, the law requires you to submit samples of your breath for testing. Will you submit the samples of your breath?

Answer NO

If the arrested person does not respond, or gives any ambiguous or conditional answer short of an unequivocal "yes," the police officer shall read the following.

Your answer is not acceptable. The law requires that you submit samples of your breath for breath testing. If you do not answer, or answer with anything other than "yes," I will charge you with refusal. Now, I ask you again, will you submit to breath testing?

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-50.22, this WARNING is to advise you that if you accept responsibility to transport or accompany the defendant, and you permit or facilitate the operation of a motor vehicle by the defendant while the defendant is intoxicated or has a blood alcohol concentration at, or above, that permitted by law (N.J.S.A. 39:4-50), then you are potentially subject to criminal penalties and civil liability.

Permitting a person who is intoxicated or who has a blood alcohol concentration at, or above, that permitted by law, to operate a motor vehicle is a violation of N.J.S.A. 39:4-50(a). If you are charged and convicted under that statute, your driving privilege will be suspended; fines and monetary penalties will be imposed; and you may be incarcerated. If you permit or facilitate the defendant to operate a motor vehicle while the defendant remains intoxicated or has a blood alcohol concentration at, or above, that permitted by law, and the defendant becomes involved in a motor vehicle collision where other persons are injured or killed, then you may be subject to indictment and criminal prosecution. If you are prosecuted and found guilty, the court can impose fines and mandatory penalties, and a prison sentence. In addition to any criminal liability, if you permit or facilitate the defendant to operate a motor vehicle while the defendant remains intoxicated or has a blood alcohol concentration at, or above, that permitted by law, and the defendant becomes involved in a motor vehicle collision where there is property damage, or personal injury or death, then you may be held liable for civil damages, and those damages may not be covered by insurance.
