On 9/27/2025, at approximately 2149 hours, Officer Depompeis and I (Officer Marquez) were dispatched to [REDACTED], in reference to a physical domestic.

Officer Depompeis initially arrived and was waived down by a resident of [REDACTED] and pointed towards apartment [REDACTED]. A female subject, identified as Sequoia Horton was standing outside [REDACTED] and asked Officer Depompeis to help her remove her husband, later identified as [REDACTED].

Upon arrival I observed Sequoia standing outside the apartment as Officer Depompeis was inside speaking with [REDACTED]. Sequoia related the following in summary, not verbatim: Sequoia has been married to [REDACTED] for more than 20 years. Prior to arriving at their apartment, the couple were in Roselle at a barbeque, where they both consumed alcohol. After the party and while the couple were enroute home to Sequoia's apartment, [REDACTED] was repeatedly being verbally abusive towards Sequoia, telling her that, "she ain't shit" amongst other things. Sequoia was upset with [REDACTED] and needed some space from him, so once they arrived at her apartment, she dropped him off and she left to a store. While she was at the store, she was receiving messages from [REDACTED] that he was going to break the door down because he didn't have the key to the apartment. Sequoia returned back to her apartment and found that [REDACTED] had not kicked down the door and she allowed him into her apartment to retrieve his things and leave. [REDACTED] was waiting for a taxi service to pick him up and Sequoia wanted him to get out of her apartment. Sequoia then started throwing [REDACTED] belongings out of the apartment to help encourage him to leave the apartment. [REDACTED] did not leave and Sequoia started pushing [REDACTED] out of the apartment. While Sequoia was pushing [REDACTED] out of the apartment she "accidentally" struck him in the nose causing him to bleed. [REDACTED] became upset with Sequoia and started spitting his blood onto Sequoia. Sequoia advised that she was not physically abused by [REDACTED] and she just wanted him out of her apartment. Although the couple have been married for more than 20 years the apartment is section 8 housing and she is unable to house [REDACTED] at the apartment. Sequoia identified herself and [REDACTED] by their names and dates of birth. Their identity was later confirmed by photo identification.

I examined Sequoia and observed that she had a dried red bloodlike substance all over her face and neck area. None of the blood appeared to be her own. I took photos of Sequoia with my phone and later submitted them into evidence, via Axon Capture.

I then entered the apartment and spoke with [REDACTED] who had slurred speech and appeared to be heavily intoxicated. Initially, [REDACTED] refused to provide a statement but reluctantly added that he was "accidentally" struck in the nose by Sequoia. [REDACTED] proudly added that he had been married to Sequoia for more than 20 years. While speaking with [REDACTED] I observed that he had scratches on his head. When I pointed out the scratches, he immediately covered his head with hands and walked to another part of the residence to place a hat on his head. I asked [REDACTED] where he had gotten the scratches and after delay [REDACTED] mumbled that he had fallen and scratched his head. Additionally, I could see that [REDACTED] had dried bloodlike substance that surrounded the inside of his nostrils. I attempted to take photos of [REDACTED] injuries, and he refused to allow me to take any photos. [REDACTED]

could not provide details, and it should be noted that it was extremely difficult to extract information from [REDACTED] due to his intoxication level and his reluctance to cooperate with my investigation.

[REDACTED]; Sequoia was clear of warrants and had a valid license. I observed that there was red bloodlike substance all throughout the apartment floor. I took photos of the blood with my department issued phone and later submitted them into evidence via Axon Capture.

Due to Sequoia's admission that she was pushing [REDACTED] out of the apartment and was the cause of [REDACTED] nosebleed, at approximately 2216 hours, Sequoia was placed under arrest for domestic battery. [REDACTED] retrieved his items from the apartment and was provided with a ride home to [REDACTED] by Officer Depompeis.

At approximately 2224 hours I transported Sequoia to Naperville Detention Center for booking, arriving at approximately 2233 hours. This incident was reviewed with ASA Kosman and Sequoia was charged with two counts of domestic battery. Sequoia was later transported to DuPage County Jail.

I have nothing further.
