### OBSERVATION

On Friday June 27, 2025 at approximately 2103 hours I responded priority two to back up Sgt. Liggett #155 on a suspicious person at 625 E Main St. Upon arrival contact was made with Sgt Liggett who was on location with a female later identified as Rachel Newberry. While speaking with Sgt. Liggett he advised me that he located the female rolling around in the grass on location. Upon him making contact Newberry Sgt. Liggett advised that she told him that she had relapsed at home by drinking alcohol and then drove to this location and continued to drink. Please refer to Sgt. Liggett's supplemental report for further information.

### AT THE SCENE

Upon speaking with Sgt .Liggett I then went and checked the vehicle of Newberry that was parked on location. The vehicle was a white Lexus sedan bearing New Jersey registration (F10MLP). The vehicle was found to be running while in a parking spot on location. While looking at the interior of the vehicle an open green wine bottle was located on the passenger side floorboard. Upon seeing this item in plan view I then went over and spoke to Newberry. Upon speaking with Newberry she stated that she had picked up alcohol from Joe Canals located on rt70. She then stated that she then drove to the parking lot where she sat in her vehicle and began to drink. While speaking with Newberry the odor of alcoholic beverage was coming from her breath. Along with this observation Newberry was slurring her speech while speaking with me and her eyes were watery and bloodshot. During this time on location Newberrys emotions were all over the place from crying to yelling at officers.

Due to the observations made on scene and what Newberry had told officers she was then placed through field sobriety. The area of the parking lot that was used for testing was dry, level and free of any debris. Officer Boehler #227 then arrived on scene and placed Newberry through HGN testing. Upon Newberry's testing with Officer Boehler I then attempted to place her through the walk and turn test. While asking if Newberry had any injuries which would prevent her from doing the test she continued to be uncooperative. While asking her about any injuries Newberry she continued to ask if I had called the

pastor and when told no she stated "Go ahead and arrest me, I don't give a fuck". Newberry was then asked again if she was willing to do the test and then continued to walk with her hands in the air. Newberry was then placed under arrest with her hands placed behind her back with handcuffs double-locked.

After placing Newberry under arrest I then did a pat down using the backside of my hand for any illegal contraband with negative findings. The rear seat of patrol vehicle 2215 was then checked for any illegal contraband with negative findings. Newberry was then read her Miranda Warnings which she acknowledged. I then drove my patrol vehicle over to where Newberrys white Lexus was located complete a search of intoxicants of the vehicle. A search of intoxicants was completed to Newberry's vehicle where an empty airplane bottle of Tito's vodka was located in the driver side door. On the passenger side floorboard was a green wine bottle that was 3/4 of the way empty. These items were confiscated and later photographed by Officer Hinkelmon #178 and secured into evidence.

### ENROUTE TO THE STATION

During transportation to police Headquarters Newberry was extremely upset and crying. During transportation Newberry continuously asked what she was being arrested for. Newberry also continuously stated that she had passed the other officers tests. Newberry also continuously asked me to call the pastor of the church.

### AT THE STATION

Upon arrival at police headquarter my gun and taser were secured in a locker. Newberry was then assisted out of patrol vehicle 2215 which checked negative for any illegal contraband. Newberry was then escorted into police headquarters for further processing. Officer Boehler was the assigned Alcotest Operator for this investigation and completed the 20-minute observation period. During the observation

period Officer Boehler #227 then read the New Jersey Standard Statement for Operations of a Motor Vehicle and during this time Newberry refused to answer the question and continued to stay "protect and serve". Due to this response Newberry was then charged with refusal. Upon the completion of the 20 minute observation period all electronic devices were removed from the room prior to the Alcotest machine being turned on. While in booking Newberry became highly uncooperative by yelling and screaming at officers. Due to these actions officers were unable to ask any questions asked on the mandatory DUI paperwork. While Newberry was cuffed to the bench she continuously pulled her left hand with the handcuff on it multiple times.

Officers were then able to get in contact with Newberry's mother identified as Gail Langford. Gail stated that she would be responding to police headquarters to pickup Newberry. Gail arrived at police headquarters where the potential liability form was completed. A copy of Gail's New Jersey drivers license was also taken. Gail was provided with a copy of the potential liability form and Newberry was released to her custody. Newberry was issued multiple traffic citations on summons number E25-003010, E25-003011, E25-003012, E25-003013. All proper DUI paperwork was completed and attached with the case file. All BWC footage along with cellblock footage from this incident was secured into evidence. Newberry was also provided with multiple resources to receive help for her alcohol addition at her request. Field notes do not exist.

On June 27th, 2025 at approximately 21:08 hours I responded priority two (2) to 625 E. Main St to assist Ptl. Arlotta #209 with a DWI investigation. Once on scene I advised the suspect Rachel Newberry we would be doing field sobriety tests. At which time I had her get to the starting position, feet together heels and toes touching with her hands at her side. I advised her to stay in this position until told to move from it. I then asked if she had any issues with her eyes to which she stated she did not. I then asked about any recent [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] While asking these questions she moved from the starting position. Once she was back in the starting position I took out my stimulus and asked Newberry to touch the top of it, at which time she utilized her whole hand to touch it. I then had her utilize just her pointer finger to which she did so. I then began testing horizontal gaze nystagmus. During each portion of the test, Newberry would stop doing the test and look away from the stimulus. Despite this I had six (6) out of six (6) hits. I was unable to do vertical due to Newberry's lack of cooperation. Ptl. Arlotta then completed the other testing.

I then proceeded to station 220 to operate the AlcoTest. Once at station 220 I visually checked Newberry's mouth to ensure it was clear of any foreign object. I then began the twenty (20) minute observation period. During this time I read Newberry the standard statement to which she began yelling "protect and serve." I then read the second part of the standard statement multiple times, to which Newberry continued to yell "protect and serve." Based on this ambiguous answer Newberry was charged with refusal. Once the twenty (20) minute observation period was complete I ensured all electronic devices were removed from the room and began utilizing the AlcoTest 7110 MKIII-C and noted that Newberry refused. A record was produced of the functioning machine. Shortly later Newberry's mother took custody of her and I cleared with no other incident.
