On June 6, 2025 at approximately 1225 hours, I responded priority two in vehicle 2206 to the area of 500 South Route 73 at Lululemon for a report of a shoplifting in progress. Prior to arriving on location Officer Magnus #162 advised that the two of the suspects exited the parking lot in a gray in color Honda sedan bearing Pennsylvania registration LRM2688. During this time Officer Verduchi advised he was stopping the vehicle in the parking lot of 5000 Sagemore Drive.

Upon arrival I assisted with detaining both suspects in the vehicle. Delshay was placed in handcuffs behind her back and double locked. She was search negative prior to entering my marked patrol vehicle #2206 and the rear was clear. I then transported Delshay Gore back to 500 South Route 73 where it was confirmed that all suspects were involved in the attempted shoplifting.

Delshay was then advised that she was under arrest for shoplifting and transported to police headquarters with no incident. The rear was checked negative before and after Delshay entering. While en route to police headquarters Delshay was advised of her Miranda warnings which she stated yes after each statement. Delshay was then turned over to Officer Magnus for the booking process. No further action taken during this time and I cleared.

I responded to the Promenade, in the area of the LuluLemon store, for a shoplifting assist. Ptl. Magnus #162 had four subjects in custody related to this shoplifting. While on scene, I searched Dilice Sears, Ayanna Dozier, and Delashay Gore, incident to arrest, which yielded in negative findings for contraband. Sears was then escorted into my marked vehicle, #2008, to the rear prisoner compartment. Prior to securing her, I completed a search of the prisoner compartment, which yielded in negative findings for debris or contraband. Sears was then secured. I then notified dispatch of my starting mileage and transported her to police headquarters.

Upon arrival, I notified dispatch of my ending mileage. I then parked my vehicle in the sallyport. I then secured my firearm into locker #4. Ptl. Smith #226 assisted me and escorted Sears into the booking area. I then completed a search of the prisoner compartment, which yielded in negative findings for debris or contraband. Upon all subjects entering the booking area, all were searched again for a secondary search, which again yielded in negative findings for contraband. All subjects were separated and in their own cells. I assisted in the booking process for all four prisoners. Please refer to the original case report for all information.

On June 6, 2025, at approximately 1225 hours, I responded in unmarked police vehicle #2304, to the area of 500 South Route 73 (Lululemon) for a report of shoplifting in progress. Central dispatch advised there was a black male wearing all black and atleast two other subjects in the store gathering items that followed the same pattern as previous shoplifting's. Upon my arrival I responded to the rear of the parking lot where I observed a black female in a white shirt and dark colored leggings talking on the phone and looking in the direction of Lululemon. The female was later identified as Dilice R. Sears. At that time, I observed a black male wearing all black clothing and carrying several pieces of clothing in his hands walking out of the store. The male matched the description of the suspect that was provided by the store and central communications, whom was still speaking with the staff, confirmed that he was involved. The male was also on the phone and looking in the direction of the Sears. Central dispatch also stated that the female I observed was involved in this shoplifting as well.

I activated my emergency lights and made contact with Sears who was walking towards a grey Honda with its passenger side door open(PA:LRM2688). Sears was escorted to the front of my vehicle and she was advised she was being detained. I then observed a black female, wearing a hat, black jacket and pants running from Lululemon and carrying a large shopping bag. I ordered the subject to walk over to me. I maintained a visual on subject, later identified as Ayanna Y. Dozier, who I observed hiding behind a black Nissan Rogue and placing the bag behind the vehicle. I ordered Dozier to walk towards me and as she did, she began to walk towards the same grey Honda that Sears was walking towards. Once I advised Dozier that another officer was responding to the scene and the vehicle's information was obtained, she began to walk towards me. Dozier was placed under arrest in handcuffs behind the back and double locked. Dozier was searched incident to arrest, found to be negative for contraband and secured in the prisoner compartment of vehicle #2304 which was searched and found to be negative for contraband. The bag of merchandise was recovered by the Lululemon staff who turned it over to me.

I detained Sears by placing her in handcuffs behind her back. Sears was read her miranda warnings and agreed to speak to police. During the interview, Sears stated that she is from Staten Island and her friends, who were in the Honda, wanted to go shopping. Sears stated they drove in the Honda from New York to Lululemon and could not explain why they chose that destination. Sears admitted to being inside the store and that she was looking through merchandise however she advised she did not take anything. It was later confirmed that Sears was inside the store and that she arrived in the Honda, since she stated her belongings would be found in there. Sears was advised that she was under arrest for shoplifting and I turned her over to Ptl. Pizzigoni who was on scene and searched her.

The male subject, later identified as Vincent Browning, ran back into the store while I was out with Dozier. Browning was later found to have dropped the clothes off back in the store, ran back to his car, snuck his way into the driver's seat and drove away. Browning was operating a grey Honda bearing PA: LRM2688 and fled while I was speaking with the Sears and Dozier. Prior to leaving I observed the passenger side front door being closed by a unknown subject with a white shirt, dark colored pants and appeared to be a small black subject. This person was later identified as Delashay Gore when Ptl. Verduchi conducting a motor vehicle stop of the Honda. Ptl. Verduchi took both Browning and Gore into custody without any issues. Browning was transported back to the parking lot of Lululemon where I was able to confirm that he was the same subject I previously observed carrying items out of the store. See Ptl. Verduchi's case supplement report for details.

Ptl. Dolphin responded to Lululemon where he turned over the recovered bag of merchandise. Ptl. Dolphin obtained a receipt for the value of the stolen merchandise and found that the total was \$2,442.00. All merchandise was turned back over to the staff. Ptl. Dolphin also confirmed with the staff that all four subjects were in the store during the time of the theft. A video request was submitted to globalinvestigations@lululemon.com for the video of this incident. Ptl. Verduchi remained with the Honda which was impounded and I will apply for a search warrant later this week.

All subjects were transported to police headquarters without any issues. I responded to police headquarters where I confirmed a secondary search was completed on all four suspects. The suspects were processed and received summons (0313-s-2025-236 to 239) for Shoplifting (2C:20-11(b)(1)). Browning was advised that his vehicle was impounded and is pending a search warrant. Browning keyfob was secured as evidence along with the receipt from Lululemon. All suspects were released from police custody after it was confirmed that they were all negative for warrants and CODIS requirement.

On the above date and time, I responded priority 2 in marked patrol vehicle #2301 for a report of a shoplifting in progress at the Lululemon at 500 S.Rte 73. Ptl. Magnus #162 was first to arrive on scene and upon making contact with the suspects, 2 suspects, 1 black male and 1 black female, entered a silver Honda sedan bearing PA reg: LRM2688 and left location towards the rear of the Promenade. 2 other suspects were detained on scene. I then upgraded my response due to the suspects attempting to leave location and upon approaching the area I deactivated my emergency lights and sirens. I observed a vehicle matching the description provided turning right in the south bound lane on Sagemore Dr. Upon approaching the vehicle from behind, I confirmed that the registration was the same that was provided and the vehicle was a silver Honda sedan. I then activated my over head lights and a motor vehicle stop was then conducted in the parking lot of 5000 Sagemore Dr.

I then approached the suspect vehicle on the passenger side and upon Ptl. Bassett #208 and Ptl. Rose #200 arriving on scene, I began to give verbal orders for the driver of the vehicle later identified as Vincent Browning and passenger Delashay Gore to exit the vehicle. Brown refused to exit the vehicle upon my initial request for him to do so. Gore exited the vehicle without issue and was cooperative.

Both subjects were detained and handcuffed behind their back. Ptl. Bassett #208 placed the handcuffs on Brown and I placed the handcuffs on Gore. Gores handcuffs were checked for proper fit and double locked. Gore was then checked for weapons, which none were located, and was placed in the rear of Ptl. Rose #200's patrol vehicle and Ptl. Bassett #208 placed Brown in the rear of his patrol vehicle.

Refer to Ofc. Rose and Ofc. Bassett's case supplemental reports. Both suspects were transported back to the Promenade where they were later confirmed to placed in custody for shoplifting. I remained on location with the vehicle and Eagle Towing was contacted to respond and impound the vehicle in the Quonset Hut. Eagle Towing responded a short time later and retrieved the vehicle and I followed Eagle Towing to the Quonset Hut where the vehicle is remaining pending a search warrant. At no time did Eagle Towing enter the vehicle and nothing was moved inside of the vehicle except the car keys that were removed from the floor board of the vehicle once the vehicle was placed in the Quonset Hut so they can be put into evidence. Quonset Hut was then secured without issue. Refer to Ptl. Magnus #162's case original report for full incident details. With nothing further to report, I cleared.

On June 6, 2025, at approximately 1225 hours I responded to 500 South Route 73 unit A19 (Lululemon) for a shoplifting in progress. Prior to my arrival Ptl. Magnus #162 was on location and had two female suspects detained in regard to the investigation. Ptl. Magnus #162 put over the radio that a black male and a black female left location in a silver sedan bearing PA registration (PA-LRM2688), the vehicle in question left out of the rear of the Promenade. Ptl. Verduchi #188 observed the vehicle and made a motor vehicle stop on the silver sedan (PA-LRM2688) matching the description provided my Ptl. Magnus #162. Ptl. Verduchi #188 conducted the motor vehicle stop in the area 5000 Sagemore Drive. I then arrived with Ptl. Verduchi #188 and we were met by the driver who was later identified as (Vincent Browning). Ptl. Verduchi #188 gave Browning multiple verbal commands to exit the vehicle and he initially refused to do so. Shortly after Browning exited the vehicle and I detained him due to the active shoplifting investigation. A pat down search for weapons was conducted and he was clear of any weapons. At this time I escorted Browning to the rear of patrol vehicle #2203, which was checked to be clear of any weapons or contraband. I then secured Browning in the rear of my patrol vehicle and the safety belt was placed around him. My starting and ending mileage was provided to Central Communications because I transported Browning from the motor vehicle stop location to the Promenade. Upon my arrival I was met by other officers on scene that were reviewing camera footage where the shoplifting took place. Upon confirmation of the Shoplifting occurring the subjects were now in custody, which I informed Browning of. Afterwards, I transported Browning to the station and my starting and ending mileage was provided to Central Communications. Upon my arrival I secured my duty issued weapon in a gun locker in the sally port. I then escorted Browning out of the rear of my patrol vehicle. My patrol vehicle was checked clear again for any weapons or contraband. I then escorted Browning to the

booking area where and I conducted a search of his persons and he was clear of any weapons or contraband. Browning only had sunglasses and a bracelet on his wrist, which he placed on the desk in the booking area and Browning removed his shoes. I then placed Browning into cell #1. Upon Browning being placed in cell #1, Ptl. Smith #225 and Ptl. Pizzigoni #184 took over the booking process. I then cleared. No further action taken.

removed and I conducted a search of the Honda Accord. During the search I located 6 clothing items with security sensors and tags belonging to Lululemon in the trunk. The items match the description of the items stolen from the Summit store. I also located a Visa card belonging to Aaron Keetly and a car belonging to Aaron Jackson which were secured as evidence. In the driver's side front door pocket, I located a consent to search, summons and court paperwork from the Montevale Police Department in the name of Vincent Jackson. In the passenger side rear door I located an Old New York Driver's License belonging to Sears in addition to a summons for shoplifting from Montevale PD. Once the search was completed Eagle Auto Towing, towed the vehicle from the Quonset Hut to the police impound lot where it was secured and is awaiting the forfeiture process with Det. Halpern.

I responded to Lululemon where I spoke with Manager Amy who advised the staff could take possession of the merchandise recovered and turn it back over to the Summit Store. Staff signed the chain of custody form and a receipt for the merchandise was recovered and found that the value was \$678.00. The receipt along with a copy of the search warrant and the seized credit cards were secured as evidence at police headquarters. I notified Det. Franchino of the recovered merchandise and provided him the suspects information from this incident. The Honda remains in police custody pending the forfeiture process.
