Narrative

On 03/31/24 at approximately 0223 hrs, I observed a black Jeep, NJ: Y48EYH traveling Northbound on State Highway 36 and Orchard Avenue with a reflective cover over the license plate obstructing the license plate. I then proceeded to stop the vehicle and make contact with the driver, Angelica Camacho of Hazlet. Upon making contact with the driver, I immediately recognize her from a previous call in the evening in which Camacho's dog had bitten her boyfriend. During that call, her boyfriend had stated that Camacho should not be driving a motor vehicle due to her consumption of alcohol. While speaking to her on the previous call I advised her not to operate her vehicle if she had consumed alcohol and was impaired, to which she advised me that she would not be driving and if needed she would call for an Uber.

While speaking with Camacho on the motor vehicle stop, I observed the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the vehicle. I asked her for her driver's license, registration and insurance. While she was searching for those items, I observed her hands to be shaking and I continued to smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle. It was at this time that I asked her to step out of her vehicle so that I could have her perform a set of Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) to determine if she should be driving a motor vehicle.

Once out of the vehicle, I had Camacho stand behind her vehicle on the side of the road. The roadway was clear of debris and level. Camacho was advised that there would be three tests and that I would explain each test to her before conducting them and she stated that she understood.

The first SFST I conducted with Camacho was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) test. I continued to smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her person. My pre-test observations were that she had equal pupil size and tracking in her eyes. During the test, I observed lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, and the onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees for a total of six clues of impairment.

The second SFST I conducted with Camacho was the Walk and Turn (WAT) test. I explained the test to her, demonstrated the test for her and then had her conduct the test. During the first set of 9 steps, Camacho took 8 steps instead of 9 and multiple steps were not heel to toe. During her second set of 9 steps multiple steps were not heel to toe.

The third SFST I conducted with Camacho was the One Leg Stand (OLS). I explained the test and demonstrated it for her. Once the demonstration portion of the test was completed, I had her perform the test. During the test, Camacho hopped for balance and counted "Fourteen-One Thousand" twice and skipped "Fifteen-One Thousand".

My observations of Camacho, and the clues of impairment during her SFST, were consistent with indicators present in a subject under the influence of alcohol. I advised Camacho that she was being placed under arrest for operating a motor vehicle under the influence and placed her in double locked handcuffs behind her person without incident. She was placed in the rear of Patrol Vehicle 1709 and was seat belted in for transport back to Highlands Police Headquarters. During the transport back to Police Headquarters, the interior of my patrol vehicle filled with the odor of an alcoholic beverage.

Once back at Police Headquarters, I read Camacho her Miranda Warning to which she stated that she did not wish to speak to me at this time. I then read her

the NJ Attorney General Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators. I advised her that the law requires her to provide samples of her breath for testing and that if she did not provide samples, that she would be charged with a refusal. Once I was done reading her the form, she advised me that she would provide samples of her breath by replying "Yes".

After the 20 minute observation was completed, I had Camacho provide samples of her breath for testing. Her breath results came back with a .137% BAC. She was advised of the test results. Once testing and processing was completed, Camacho had a sober driver pick her up and take her to her vehicle to retrieve her dog prior to the vehicle being towed for John's Law. Patrolman Flores stood by with the vehicle while we attempted to have a family member retrieve the dog so that the vehicle could be towed. Due to the dog biting someone on a previous call, patrol did not want to remove the dog from the vehicle without the owner present. Once Camacho retrieved the dog, Hennessey's towing arrived on scene and towed the vehicle for John's Law.

Camacho was given a court date in Highlands Municipal Court of 04/16/24 at 3pm. Camacho was issued summonses for the following:
